Dear Mr. Wong:

The Department has reviewed your application received on January 3, 2011, for the use of Flush/Drain Free as a septic system additive, in accordance with Section 15.027 of Title 5 (310 CMR 15.000).

It has been determined that this product, as described in the application, will not harm the septic system components, including the biomat, or adversely affect system function or the environment when used on a schedule recommended by the manufacturer.

The Department hereby allows the use of this product as a septic system additive subject to the following conditions:

1. The allowed use is for Flush/Drain Free additive only, as described and contained in Permit Application BRP WP 62, application # X236096 received on January 3, 2011 and not an approval for any other additive produced or equipment distributed by General Environmental Science Corporation ("the Company") or by any other entity.
2. Prior to distribution of these septic system additives for sale or use, the Company shall test each product batch for the presence of Enteric Pathogens, including Salmonella, Shigella, Campylobacter, utilizing American Public Health Association methods for the identification and isolation of enteric pathogens. The presence of enteric pathogens in any product batch shall result in discarding the whole batch in accordance with applicable requirements. The Company shall maintain testing results for three years following each testing date.



General Environmental Science Corporation shall notify the Department at least thirty (30) days in advance of the proposed transfer of ownership of the corporation or of the right to produce the product for which this allowance is issued. Notification shall include the name and address of the new owner/entity and a written agreement between the existing and new owner/entity containing a specific date of transfer. All provisions of this allowance shall be applicable to the successors and assigns of the Company.
4. The Department's determination to allow the use of this product does not constitute an endorsement or approval with respect to the benefit, effectiveness, or performance of the additive. Any promotional representation that refers to the allowance of this product shall include the sentence:

"Allowance of this product does not represent an endorsement or approval by the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection with respect to the effectiveness or performance of this product".


